- 3) TWO pencils

- 5) ONE red <u>and</u> ONE green BALLPOINT pen for correcting and color-coding essays
- 6) pencil pouch to keep everything in its place
- 7) small stapler with staples
- 8) personal bottle of hand-sanitizer

**Buy extra quantities of the above supplies so that you have enough for the ENTIRE school year.

Printing:

Students will be asked to print final and sometimes rough drafts. For this reason, it is important for students to have a reliable printer. Running out of paper or ink does not excuse an assignment from being counted as late. Late final drafts will have 10% of the score deducted and must be turned in within ONE school day of the original due date.
